Program Support: STMAA supports all instrumental and choral ensembles at Santa Teresa High School. The school budget provides our fine classroom teachers – but almost everything else required to support these programs is provided by STMAA.

Membership: If you have a student enrolled in any music class at Santa Teresa you are automatically a member of STMAA.

Volunteer Participation: Volunteer participation and fundraising are absolutely essential in order to make these programs available to our students. Involvement in STMAA activities is a good way to meet other parents and students and to find out what's happening around the school.
