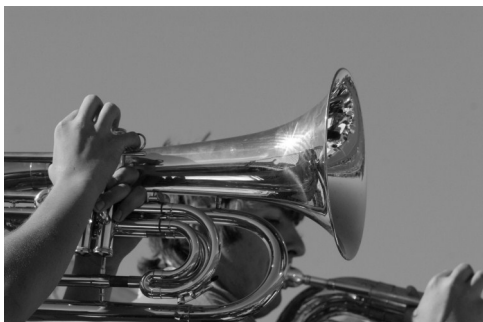

OUR NEEDS

A Volunteer-supported Band

The STHS Marching Band is a self-funded organization. Like all public schools, Santa Teresa High School has been hit by major budget cutbacks. Only the classroom teaching staff is funded by the state. The rest of our budget comes from the students, their family, and contributions.

No student is turned away from the music program due to financial reasons. All students are encouraged to participate in fundraising efforts, but it is contributions from outside supporters that keeps band fees in check.



Contributions and band fees are used to support all portions of the band.

- Uniforms**
 The current STHS uniforms were purchased over 10 years ago. While they have been lovingly maintained, new uniforms appropriate to the California climate are required.
- Competition fees and travel expenses**
 This includes transportation of students and instruments, as well as entry fees, food, and lodging.
- Music and Show Design**
 All music played by the band, as well as the field show, drill, and choreography must be purchased.
- Instruments**
 The school maintains a limited number of instruments for students' use. Large instruments, like sousaphones, are overdue for replacement.
- Growth and Overhead**
 In addition to instruction by our outstanding classroom instructors led by Director Julie Bounds, the band also employs part-time and guest instructors. While we keep office overhead to a minimum, some expenses cannot be avoided.
